This fortnight's focus is

Cinderella

We are using the book '*Cinderella*' in the Maintained Nursery during the next two weeks as part of our teaching and learning with the focus song '*The Princess Lost her Shoe*' and the focus sound '*P - Peter Puppy*'.

Our teaching and learning will be focused on Understanding the World, with children being encouraged to think about cause and effect. This includes investigating cars and ramps, and ICT equipment. We will have cleaning materials set up to encourage the children's role play. The children will also be learning about fairytales and traditional tales. In Maths we will be thinking about time, focussing on our daily routine.



SUPPORTING AT HOME

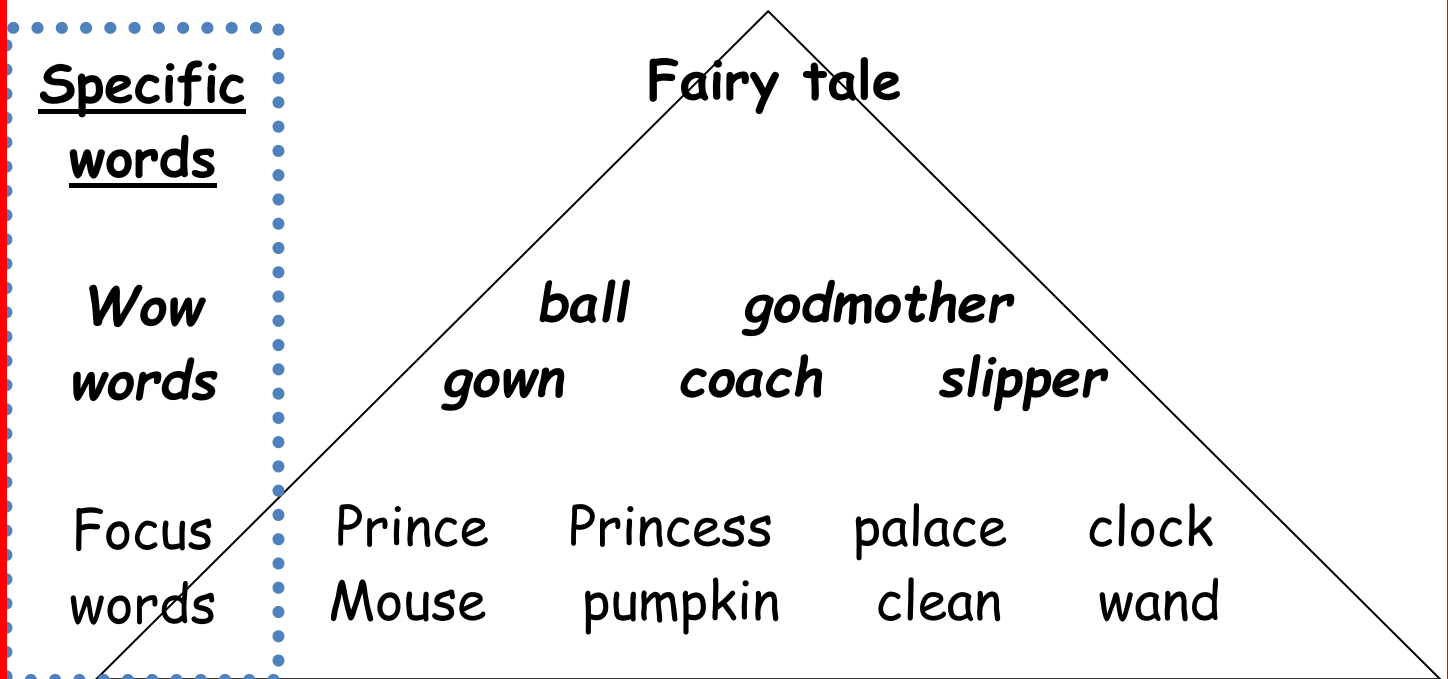


- Sing the focus song and focus letter song together.

- Have a sound hunt for things that begin with the focus sound, e.g. puppet, pet, police car, pink
- Read some traditional stories - such as The Three Little Pigs, Sleeping Beauty, the Billy Goats Gruff - and talk about the characters and settings.
- Encourage your child to talk about their daily routine and what they enjoy doing.

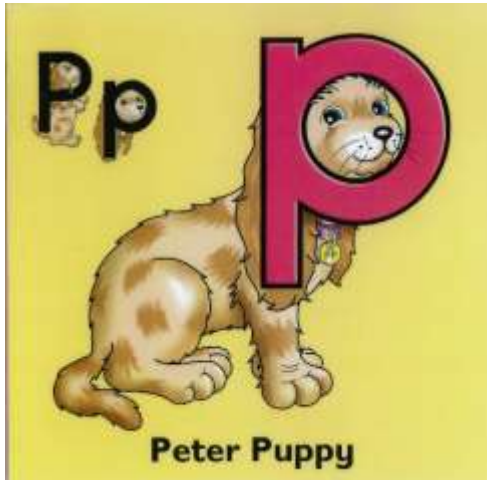
